A. Third cycle course: 2, 5 higher education credits

The course was adopted and the syllabus approved by the Board of the Department of Human Geography, Lund University, 2014-04-01. This syllabus is valid from 2014-04-01.

B. Course Details

The course is offered as a single subject course at the PhD level.

The language of instruction is Swedish or English.

C. Learning Outcomes

On completion of the course, the student shall be able to:

- demonstrate knowledge and understanding of relevant literature in the field of study
- be aware of, and critically assess, contributions within the field of study
- present their own research orally

D. Course Content

The course offers insights into a specialized field of study within Human geography, chosen to meet the particular research needs of the student.

E. Teaching and Assessment

Assessment is based on submitting and presenting a paper at a conference. The paper should be written and presented according to the standards specified by the conference organizers.

F. Grades

The grades awarded are Pass or Fail. To receive Pass, the student must fulfil the learning outcomes and participate actively in the course.

G. Admission Requirements.

Applicants must be Ph.D. students in the discipline.

H. Literature

Literature is selected jointly by student and supervisors.
